Yingwati Pty Ltd is an Aboriginal owned and family company incorporated on the 23rd December 2015, its creation was the result of two families coming together as one. An Aboriginal family having traditional and cultural affiliations to lands/seas in the Northern Territory and the other family migrating to Darwin some 60 years ago from Kalymnos.

The coming together as one respects and acknowledges the need to deal with **“breaking poverty and the dependence cycle”** as one family travelled from Kalymnos by boat in search of a better life whilst the other family was capture by the policies of the day that instituted dependence.

*Yingwati is a Tiwi name for “wild honey” and the Kalymnos name for honey is “Meli”.
